Speaker: Prof. Ngaiming Mok (The University of Hong Kong)

Introduction:

Professor Ngaiming Mok is the Chair Professor at the University of Hong Kong and Director of the Institute of Mathematical Research HKU. His research interests encompass Several complex variables, differential geometry and Algebraic geometry. He have obtained the prestigious 1985 US Presidential Young Investigator Award, 2007 State Natural Science Award of China and 2009 Bergman Prize of AMS, etc. He was an Invited Speaker at the International Congress of Mathematicians in Zurich (ICM 1994), served as a Core Member on the Panel for Algebraic and Complex Geometry for ICM 2006 in Madrid, and was appointed Member of the Fields Medal Committee for ICM 2010 in Hyderabad.
